



TALLINN, Nov 23, BNS - The council of foreign investors operating in Estonia sent a letter to the prime minister, expressing support to the government's budget policy and euro aspirations.

The Council said that while it might not agree on some of the details of current and past policies, it would like to express its full support to the difficult and courageous steps that the government was now taking.

In terms of its budget Estonia stands out among its troubled neighbors as well as some richer West-European nations, the Council said.

If Estonia gets an invitation to the euro zone next year, the Council found, it would mean new foreign direct investments and new growth of the economy. Also tourism and trade will profit from by the introduction of the euro.
